JOB CODE TITLE: PAINTER

HRIS TITLE: PAINTER

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CLASS: Works under general supervision, with on-the-job supervision being minimal. Has the authority to inspect and determine the need for repairs or painting; recommend ordering of materials and equipment; determine and select alternatives in materials or equipment. Performs skilled painting duties in the maintenance, repairing and inspection of State facilities. Work product consists of Buildings and State facilities painted and in good repair and operation. Responsible for accomplishing all tasks in a timely and efficient manner; adhering to and assuring all safety rules are followed.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Receives work orders, the orders appropriate paints, enamels, lacquers, thinners and other materials. Mixes paints according to desired consistency for surface to be covered. Matches colors or creates colors according to general or specific instructions. Sets up surface to be covered by masking and laying tarpaulin. Applies coating to surface with spray gun, brush, or roller. Cleans tools after use, and removes protective masking and covering. Sets-up ladders, scaffolding. Removes fixtures which cannot be masked. May use a silk-screen process for certain types of sign painting or artistic designs. Keeps records on work completed and materials used. May instruct or supervise building maintenance technicians or prison inmates. Performs related work as required.

WORK CONDITIONS: Hazards associated with maintenance, fumes and powered and non-powered tools and equipment; work can encounter extremes of climate conditions; travel as required; may work with prison inmates.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of: Methods and practices involved in remodeling, construction and painting; blueprints, sketches and structural components of buildings; common and specialized tools, equipment and materials related to the trade; common safety practices; estimating, costing and ordering supplies and materials; policies and procedures established for the work system.

Skill/Ability to: reading and understanding blueprints, sketches and schematics relating to buildings; using common and specialized tools, equipment and materials; the trade of painter; oral and written communications; performing a full range of physical motions, sometimes working at heights; ordering and estimating materials and costs; interpersonal relationships.

SPECIAL SELECTION FACTORS: Some positions may require possession of a valid Arizona driver's license at a level appropriate to the position/assignment and retention of said license during the period of employment. A medical/physical evaluation is required prior to appointment. Four years of commercial/residential painting experience which included at least one year each of interior and exterior painting experience. Any combination of training and experience that meet the knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSAs) may be substituted.
