JOB CODE SERIES: Mechanical Equipment Operation Series

JOB CODE TITLE: EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I

HRIS TITLE: EQP OPER I

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CLASS: Under general supervision, is responsible for the operation of small and medium sized vehicles and equipment; and performs related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Operates buses, single axle flatbed and dump trucks to pick up, haul, and deliver supplies, materials and equipment; operates tractor-mounted power mowers; operates two-wheel drive front-end loaders; operates jackhammers, weed sprayers and weed burners; sets out traffic cones and flags and directs traffic; operates small tractors; loads and unloads vehicles; assures that vehicles and equipment are properly serviced and maintained; performs minor maintenance and repair on equipment; drives or tows equipment to the work site and unloads equipment and supplies from truck or trailer.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of: the safe operation of cars, trucks and buses; the operation of motorized construction equipment; preventative maintenance of equipment.

Skill in: the operation of cars and small and medium trucks; the operation of motorized equipment.

Ability to: learn to operate vehicles and equipment safely; follow oral and simple written instructions.

Experience and Education: Typical ways to obtain the KSAs would be:

- Literacy and one year of motorized vehicles and construction equipment operation experience.
- Any combination of training and experience that meet the knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSAs) may be substituted.

SPECIAL SELECTION FACTORS: A class B chauffeur's license is required. A class A chauffeur's license may be required on certain assignments. A medical/physical evaluation is required prior to appointment.
