JOB CODE TITLE: PUBLIC HEALTH NUTRITIONIST

HRIS TITLE: PUB HLTH NUTRST

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CLASS: Under general direction, provides public health nutrition services of considerable difficulty; has responsibility for a major specialized program or conducts a comprehensive nutrition program for a multiple county health district or for a single county health department serving a population of 400,000 or more; and performs related work as required.

This class serves as the full journeyman level in the series. It is distinguished from the Public Health Nutritionist I by the performance of the more complex duties and the higher degree of independence exercised.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Plans, develops, implements and evaluates nutrition programs, services and educational activities; coordinates nutrition services with operating public health programs; establishes and maintains cooperative relationships with civic, governmental and educational groups; evaluates nutrition problems and makes recommendations for proposed projects; participates in the in-service training of various professional staffs and special groups; provides consultation on nutrition services to hospitals, nursing homes, rehabilitation centers and other facilities for group care; prepares and reviews materials for various communication media; studies and surveys on the relationship of dietary factors to health and disease.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

Knowledge of: public health nutrition; the responsibilities of Federal, State and local governments in nutrition and allied fields; research methods.

Skill/Ability to: analyze nutritional problems and make sound determinations for their prevention and control; communicate effectively; establish and maintain effective relationships with others.

SPECIAL SELECTION FACTORS: Two years of experience equivalent to Public Health Nutritionist I; or a Master's degree in Nutrition or in Public Health with emphasis in nutrition plus one year of experience equivalent to Public Health Nutritionist I; or a Master's degree in Nutrition or in Public Health with emphasis in nutrition plus an internship approved by the American Dietetic Association.
