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**ORGANIZATION/WORK SETTINGS:** Highways Division Department of Transportation

**WORK DESCRIPTION:** Takes and develops aerial photographs requested for use in photogrammetric mapping and by other Sections within the agency; maintains extensive aerial photograph files.

**WORK ACTIVITIES:** operates aerial photographic equipment for mapping and reconnaissance from airplane.

Mixes photo developing and finishing chemicals and develops aerial negative film.

Uses film processor in darkroom for developing film.

Hand-develops film in processing sinks or trays.

Develops film and produces black and white prints in darkroom.

Maintains record of field expenses, including telephone calls, gas and other auto expenses

Searches for and retrieves information from files, and responds to informational requests requiring some judgment or discretion regarding current and specific business of the work system, as reflected in the records; this communication may be by telephone or by direct personal contact.

Attends staff meetings of work unit or section, under direction of work supervisor; gives and receives information helpful in work unit or work system operation.

Gives and receives information requiring considerable judgment and authority regarding current and specific business of the work unit by telephone or direct contact.

Maintains photo files and waits on customers at photo order and sales desk.

**WORK CONDITIONS:** Considerable amount of time spent flying; frequent daily travel.

**SUPERVISION:** Works under the general direction of a first-line supervisor and exercises considerable independent judgment within established program parameters and guidelines.

**WORK RESULTS/PRODUCTS:**

Completed series of pictures of requested area of the State; completed flight plans.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Precision and accuracy of aerial photographs according to mapping scales; proper use, operation, and maintenance of expensive photographic equipment.

**AUTHORITY:** Determines if flight conditions are appropriate for aerial photography; makes recommendations for flight schedules.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

**Knowledge of:** Equipment, procedures and techniques used in aerial photography; methods, procedures and techniques used in processing film; ground orientation and identification techniques used in aerial photography; principles and practices of surveying and mapping.

**Skill in:** operating a variety of photographic equipment.

**Ability to:** issue verbal instructions to the pilot while in flight; plan appropriate flight schedules; interpret map and aerial photos.
